



Questions and Answers: RFPs for Workshop Content and Facilitation

General

- Understanding both workshops share similar formats and frameworks, is CTAA expecting to receive two separate proposal responses and plans for the two RFPs?
 - Yes, there should be a separate proposal in response to each RFP. CTAA may choose a consultant for one workshop but not the other.
- Should respondents plan to conduct the surveys and workshops separately?
 - Yes, because CTAA may select different consultants for each workshop, and they are expected to have different attendees.
- The timelines also differ by a few days for each deadline for the two workshops. Should we expect the audience to be similar between the two workshops?
 - CTAA expects the workshops to have different attendees. There may be overlap but it is best to assume different groups of people.
- What would be the size of the target audience we are expecting for the survey assessment and for the workshop?
 - CTAA expects the audience to be about 20 people.
- To conduct the virtual workshop and survey, is there a preferred/required platform by CTAA (e.g., SurveyMonkey, Google Forms, etc.) to be used?
 - There is no preferred survey platform by CTAA, as long as it is easily administered.
 - To conduct the workshop, CTAA anticipates using Zoom, but encourages proposals to suggest alternatives or add-on tools (e.g. Pear Deck, Muro)
- Is the “General Framework” section considered the minimal or required components of the workshop, or is this given as a suggested outline that could be reorganized or modified during the workshop framework finalization phase?
