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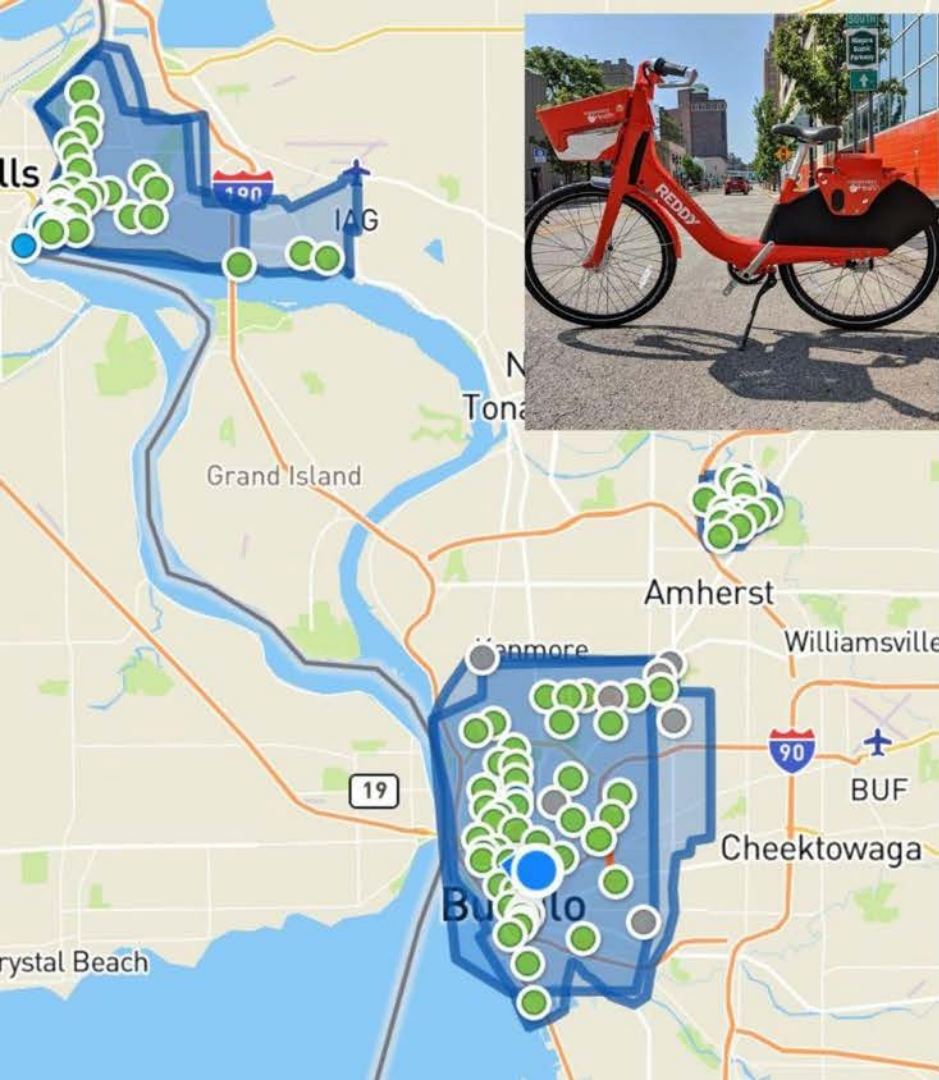

CDTA Overview

- 750 employees
- 2,300 sqm footprint, 3 divisions, 300+ vehicles
- \$113M budget
- Fixed-route, BRT Lines, STAR (paratransit), Commuter, On Demand, CDPHP *Cycle!*, Seasonal services, *DRIVE*
- Regional Community Partner



Route Network

- 50+ Routes serving the Capital Region
- 10 Million Trips Annually
- 2017 Mid-Size Transit System of the Year
- Transit solutions for businesses, service providers, colleges and municipalities
- Growing platform of mobility services



Micro Mobility Options

- *FLEX* On Demand - CDTA ride-sharing service that offers curb-to-curb travel
- *DRIVE* – electric car sharing
- CDPHP *Cycle!* – Regional bike-sharing program with 500 bicycles at 100 stations

Meet CDPHP *Cycle!*

- 1st transit authority run bike share system
- Launched in 2017 with 80 bikes in 4 cities
- Now grown to 400+ pedal bikes in 8 cities as far north as Lake George and west as Amsterdam



CYCLE!SM

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Who rides *Cycle!* ?

- Commuting
 - Weekdays on main thoroughfares
 - First mile, last mile
- Recreation
 - Trails and bike paths
- Group rides
- Community Events



Universal Access

- Offers unlimited access to CDTA's network
- Employees/students access services by swiping their ID card, CDTA *Navigator* smart card or mobile ticket
- “Free” access a great incentive for customers to ride regularly
- Program paid for through an agreement with an annual fee



What's Next For *Cycle!* ?

- Mobility Hubs:
- Multiple mobility options
- Construction expected to be complete mid-late 2023

Includes:

- Bus Rapid Transit
- Fixed Route
- CDPHP *Cycle!*
- *DRIVE* car share



E-Bike Excitement !!

- New partnerships in 2023 with Drop Mobility (product and technology) and Shared Mobility Inc. (Operations)
- Fleet will combine current pedal bikes with 200+ pedal assist electric bikes
- Staggered deployment this Spring throughout the network
